

# TUXEDO RECREATION SUMMER DAY CAMP

## VITAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION INCLUDED

The summer program for the Town of Tuxedo will begin on Tuesday June 29th, and will run for six weeks ending August 6th. (**Camp is closed Monday, July 5th**) The program begins at 9:00 A.M. and ends at 2:00 P.M. All children not being bused home should be picked up promptly at that time. The program will be offered to **residents** of Tuxedo who are **properly registered** for the program. Children entering 1st through 8th grade are eligible. The Recreation Department has established eligibility guidelines for participation in all of its programs. If you have any questions regarding eligibility, please call the office at 351-2265.

All children will report to the Tuxedo Elementary School multi-purpose room every morning at 9:00 A.M. Monday through Thursday. The School is closed on Fridays, therefore we will be going on Day Trips every Friday. Regular bus routes will be in effect and will arrive at the School parking lot to pick up walkers and drop offs. Camp attendance will be taken on the buses. Once attendance is complete we will continue on to our trip destination. The Tuxedo Summer Camp program will consist of various activities such as crafts, archery, organized sports, culture celebrations swimming, games, and other scheduled activities. There will be a supervised lunch period between 11:00 - 12:00. Bag lunches are necessary. **THERE ARE NO FACILITIES TO PURCHASE ANY FOOD OR DRINKS.** An extra snack and drink are also suggested.

Along with scheduled activities at the school four days a week, there will be a full day split swim program at the Wee Wah Beach Club in Tuxedo Park. This split session will allow more swim time for the campers. The morning swim program (1st through 3rd grade) will leave the school promptly at 9:15 A.M. and the afternoon swim program (4th through 8th grade) will leave the school promptly at 11:40 A.M. Any time a camper arrives late to camp they must be signed in with their counselor as well as the Assistant Director. ***All campers must be present on the bus to participate in the swim program. Parents may not drive their children to the beach, again the children must ride the bus to the beach.***

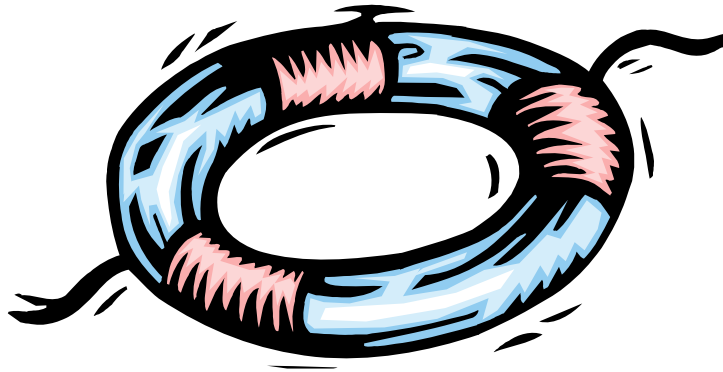
During the swim program, the children will be given a swim lesson based on their ability. They will then have supervised "Free Swim." **All children** are asked to have a **beach bag** containing a **swimsuit, towel, and a change of clothes**. A snack, bottle of water, and sun block are also suggested. Any student going on the bus to the beach **MUST** participate in swimming lessons.

## *Waterfront Information*

Each year parents have questions about the swimming lessons and how well the waterfront is supervised. First, all children are expected to follow certain general rules. They are all assigned to a waterfront area based on their swimming ability. They are expected to stay in that assigned area unless given permission to leave by their instructor. Each swimmer **must** have a "**buddy**" or partner at all times. There will be periodic checks by the lifeguards to make sure that partners are together. All children are told what areas are "off limits" and which areas they may be in. Children not following directions and rules will be dealt with according to the severity of the infraction. Penalties given include verbal warnings, bench time, (sitting on a bench with no participation), suspension from the program for one or two days, and lastly, expulsion from the program.

Our recreation water staff will include a Waterfront Director, certified in water safety instruction, lifeguarding, first aide, and CPR. There will also be at least three on duty lifeguards, a beach Medical Director, a camp Assistant Director, and several other camp counselors, some of which will also be certified in first aide and CPR.

**One Warning Policy**

This program is designed for 6 weeks of fun. Under no circumstances will we tolerate bullying, kids being rude to camp employees, being disruptive on the bus or using foul language. Parents will receive a phone call describing the behavior that took place along with a warning that if it happens again the child will be expelled from camp without a refund.

## **FRIDAYS will be "Special Event Day."**

The First Friday of Camp, July 2nd a trip to "*The Castle*" is scheduled. The cost per child is \$13.00 and includes Mini Golf, Go-Karts and kids choice of Lazer Tag or Lazer Maze. Children should bring a bag lunch or extra money for food. All other Fridays we will be going to the Platzl Brauhaus in Pomona, NY. at the additional cost of \$15.00 per child. This will include recreation and relaxation, there's *swimming* in the large outdoor pool, shuffleboard, basketball, tennis and miniature golf. Toss a shoe or two - you may become the Platzl Brauhaus horseshoe champ. Roll your way to fame ... at Platzl Brauhaus, they get excited about their Bocci games. **A BBQ Lunch is included in the cost.**

Please be sure to send children with cash in an envelope to cover the cost of the trip. Children who come unprepared will be sent home. *Children who are not enrolled in Camp and wish to attend the trips only may do so, for an additional fee of \$50.00.* See registration form. Children will be sent home at 2:15 P.M. on trip days. **If possible please dress your child in a RED T-Shirt on trip days.**

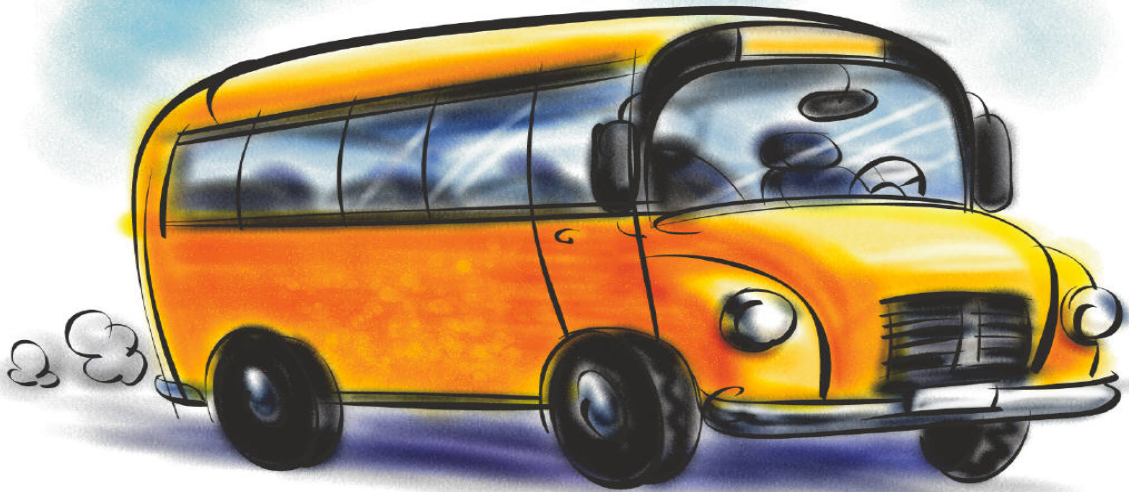
### **RAIN OUTS**

## **Busing**

Busing fees are \$150.00 per family for the 6 week program. The schedule is not designed to be as extensive as the regular school bus, but rather busing from spot pick-ups. We will be using only Tuxedo Transportation Employees to serve you this summer. If you will be using this service at all during the summer, **you must pay the full \$150.00 when you register.** Children will not be allowed on the bus unless payment has been made. Bus schedules will be created and customized by using the sign up sheet. Please register as early as possible with your full physical address. You can expect a letter of correspondence with your bus stop time & location the week of June 21st.



# **SPORT CLINICS**

*Monday through Thursday*

## **BASEBALL CLINIC**

*No Fee Required*

The Summer Recreation Program will be running a baseball clinic for children entering 4th through 8th grades. **The program will begin on Monday July 12th and will run through Thursday, July 15th.** The baseball clinic will meet Monday through Thursday during that week. The clinic will begin at 9:00 A.M and will run until 12:30 P.M. Children should meet the coach at the Tuxedo Elementary School Multi-purpose Room at 9:00A.M. After the clinic a bus will take the children registered in the summer day camp program to the beach for a short swim. You do not have to be registered for the regular recreation program in order to register for this clinic. Please bring your mitt, lunch, bathing suit (if enrolled in day camp), and plenty to drink. There is no registration fee. This clinic is funded by grant monies obtained from NYS Division for Youth.

## **BASKETBALL CAMP**

*No Fee Required*

Once again, we will be conducting a basketball skills camp for children entering 4th through 8th grades. **The camp will run from 9:00 A.M. until 12:30 P.M. on Monday July 19th through Thursday, July 22nd.** Children should meet their coach in the Elementary School Multi-purpose Room at 9:00. The basketball clinic will meet Monday through Thursday during that week. At 12:30 P.M. those children registered in the summer day camp program will be bused to the beach for a short swim. Please bring your lunch, bathing suit and plenty to drink. In order to participate in this program, you do not have to be registered in the regular summer day camp program. There is no registration fee. This clinic is funded by grant monies obtained from the NYS Division for Youth.

## **SOCCER CLINIC**

*No Fee Required*

The third clinic of the summer will be a soccer clinic. We are offering a Soccer Clinic for children in 4th-8th grade beginning **on July 26th and running through July 29th.** The Clinic will be held from 9:00 A.M. to 12:30 P.M. Children enrolled in the clinic should meet their coach in the Elementary School Multi-purpose Room at 9:00 A.M. At 12:30 there will be a bus available to take the children who are also enrolled in camp up to the Wee Wah for a short swim. Clinic participants who are not enrolled in the camp program must be picked up at the school. Participants should bring a lunch and plenty of drinks. There is no fee for this clinic. This clinic is funded by grant monies obtained from the NYS Division of Youth Services. You do not have to be registered for the regular recreation program in order to register for this clinic.

## Preschool Program

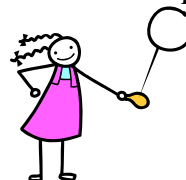
\$150.00 for 6 weeks

The Tuxedo Preschool Program will Begin on **Tuesday June, 29th** and runs for six weeks, until **August, 6th**. **Children participating may be between the ages of 2 ½ by June 1, 2010 and Pre-K**. Proof of age is required upon registration. Children in this program must be toilet trained and must be able to be left without a parent for a short period of time. The program will be held on Monday through Thursday from 9:00 to 12:30 A.M.

There will be a simple craft, a story, games, outside play at Circle Field and other happenings to help the children to adjust to a structured time period, to cooperate among peer groups, and to follow simple directions, while having fun.

### **Children need to bring a bag lunch and plenty to drink.**

The Preschool program instructors Karen and Tony own and operate a Preschool in Greenwood lake during the regular school year. The children just love them and we are blessed to have them as part of our camp program.



### PRESCHOOL SWIM

*Must be 3 years of age by July 1st*

For an additional \$45.00 Parents have the option to choose to pick up their child at 11:15 and take them to the WeeWah Beach for a 45 minute swim lesson.

Swim lessons will start promptly at 11:30am on Tuesday and Thursday.

**This program will start Tuesday, July 6th and end Thursday, August 5th.**

The Preschool Swim program will familiarize young children with water safety and the water. The program will begin to teach basic water skills, but will not "drown-proof" a child or give them adequate skills to allow them in any water unsupervised by an adult. The lessons are primarily designed to help children overcome their initial fear of water.

**DISCLOSURE**

The Tuxedo Recreation Summer Day Camp is licensed by the New York State Department of Health. The camp is required to be inspected twice yearly. Inspection reports are filed with the Orange Health Department, Goshen, New York, and are available to the public.

All registration forms **must be completed and mailed in by June 15, 2010**. This includes registration forms, immunization forms (for new children), fees, and proof of age when required. **There will be a late fee of \$10.00 for any registrations submitted after the June, 15th deadline.**
