Another way to see the presentation is at the next Climate Smart Task Force meeting on February 16th via the Town's Zoom. She will soon meet with NYS DOT to discuss cross walks and streetscapes along Route 17.

- Councilmember Reichgott is working on an inventory of Town owned properties. He cautioned drivers in the winter weather conditions.
