

How To Apply For A Copy Of A Death Certificate

Who is eligible to get a copy of a death certificate?

- The spouse, parent, child or sibling of the deceased
- Other people who have one of the below:
 - Documented Lawful Right or Claim
 - Documented Medical Need
 - New York State Court Order

If you are not the spouse, parent, child or sibling of the deceased you must document a lawful right or claim. For example, you may need a death certificate to claim a benefit. You would need an official letter from the agency saying you need the death record to process the claim.

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- Fill out form “Application for Copy of Death Record” (DOH-294A) and provide identification:

1 from A or 2 from B:

A. One of the following forms of valid photo-ID:

- Driver's license
- State-issued, nondriver photo-ID card
- Passport
- U.S. Military-issued, photo-ID

OR

B. Two of the following showing the applicant's name and address:

- Utility or telephone bill
- Letter from a government agency dated within the last six months

- Completed “Notarized Identity Verification” Form (if applying by mail)
- **There is a \$10 fee for the search and a copy, if found.** Check, Cash or Credit Card are accepted forms of payment. Checks are made out to the “Town of Tuxedo”
- Please include a self-addressed envelope if you would like it mailed and include an overnight envelope and postage if it needs to be expedited
