A local law Video Conferencing - Amendment of Chapter 25

Section 1. The Code of the Town of Tuxedo is hereby amended to add a new Chapter 25 entitled "Video Conferencing" which shall read as follows:

Section 25-1. Legislative Intent: It is the intent of this Chapter to give the town board, and the town's public bodies as that term is defined in Public Officers Law Section 102, the authority to participate in meetings via video conference in a manner consistent with the town's videoconferencing policy and the authority granted in Public Officers Law Section 103-a.

Section 25-2. Authority: This Chapter is adopted pursuant to Public Officers Law Section 103-a which expressly authorizes the town board to adopt a local law giving the town board and public bodies the authority to participate in meetings via videoconference from locations not accessible to the public so long as a quorum of the board/body participates from locations where the public may be physically present and other conditions are met.

Section 25-3. Videoconferencing for Public Meetings: The Town Board of the Town of Tuxedo hereby authorizes members of the town board, and all members of the town's public bodies, to participate in meetings using videoconferencing technology in a manner consistent with Public Officers Law Section 103-a and the town's videoconferencing policy adopted by the town board.

Section 25-4. Severability: If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 2. Effective date: This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
