





WHAT IS TOWN OF TUXEDO COMMUNITY POWER?


Town of Tuxedo Community Power empowers the Town of Tuxedo to pool local electricity demand in order to leverage the collective buying power of residents and small businesses in an effort to secure more favorable terms on their electricity supply, protect consumers, and choose renewable generation sources. The program has one offering: community choice electricity supply.

WHAT IS COMMUNITY CHOICE AGGREGATION (CCA)?

- Energy purchase program authorized by the NYS Public Service Commission (PSC) in April 2016
- Allows municipalities to aggregate energy demand and negotiate bulk purchase
- Shift the selection of the default supplier from the state (the utility) to your local municipality
- All energy customers are eligible to participate, but some are automatically in the program (opt-out) and some must opt-in based on their service classification







- Consumer protection through partnership oversight





Frequently Asked Questions

Does this program replace my utility company?

No. You continue to only pay your utility bill (with a line-item change) and your utility remains responsible for delivery and maintenance of the electrical grid.

Does this impact the reliability of my electricity?

No, your utility continues to deliver you electricity and provides the same service whether you are participating in the program or not.



Frequently Asked Questions

Will this save me money?

Savings are not guaranteed.

What if I want to change my supply choice?

Once the program launches, you may call the helpline or fill out the Enrollment/Change form on website to change your supply section, opt-out, or opt back into the program, with no fees or penalties.



Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to stay in the program the entire time?

No, you may opt-out or opt back in at any time during the length of the contract with no fees or penalties.

 Can I participate if I have my own solar panels or if I participate in community solar?

Yes, even if you use solar power, you are still required to have a supplier on your Orange and Rockland bill to cover any electricity that isn't provided by your solar.

What happens after the program ends?

The contract ends and your municipality may choose to go out to bid again for another contract. If they choose to not continue the program, you will automatically switch back to Orange and Rockland selecting your supply on your behalf.
