## 6. Resolution Fair Housing:

RESOLVED, motion made by Deputy Supervisor Lindsay, seconded by Councilmember May;
The Town of Tuxedo supports Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Law) and the New York State Human Rights Law. It is the policy of the Town of Tuxedo to implement programs to ensure equal opportunity in housing for all person regardless of race, color, religion, ancestry, sex (including pregnancy), national origin, nationality, familial status, marital or domestic partnership status, affectional or sexual orientation, atypical hereditary cellular or blood trait, genetic information, liability for military service, mental or physical disability, perceived disability, AIDS/HIV status and Lawful Income or Source of Lawful Rent Payment (Section 8). The Town of Tuxedo further objects to discrimination in the sale, rental, leasing, financing of housing or lands to be used for construction of housing, or in the provision of brokerage services because of race, color, religion, ancestry, sex, national origin, handicap or disability as prohibited by Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Law) and the New York State Human Rights Law. Therefore, the Town Board of the Town of Tuxedo does hereby approve the following resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Tuxedo shall publicize this resolution and through this publicity shall cause owners of real estate, developers, and builders to become aware of their respective

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responsibilities and rights under the Federal Fair Housing Law, the New York State Human Rights Law, and any local laws or ordinances.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the municipality will at a minimum include, but not limited to: (1) the printing and publicizing of this resolution, a fair housing public notice and other applicable fair housing information through local media, community contacts and placement on the Municipal website and in other social media; (2) distribution of posters, flyers, and any other means which will bring to the attention of those affected, the knowledge of their respective responsibilities and rights concerning equal opportunity in housing.
